

Equipment List for the Well-Prepared Scout for Troop Monthly Campouts*

<u>Quantity</u>	<u>ITEM</u>
1	Bag dinner and drink for Friday evening meal
1	Class "A" uniform shirt
1	Pair of Scout Shorts (will need 2 for summer camp)
1	Scout belt
2	Scout socks (several pairs for summer camp)
2	Troop 243 T-shirts (\$10 each – will need 2 more for summer camp)
1	Pair of Scout pants (optional, but recommended)
2	Boxers/underwear (will need several for summer camp)
1	Pair of closed-toed shoes to wear camping (boots, tennis shoes)
1	Backpack (try Earth Outfitters or on-line via our Website)
1	Sleeping bag (good for 30 degrees, smaller is better for packing)
1	Air mattress or similar (must fit in pack)
1	Poncho (serves as rain cover for the backpack as well)
1	Toiletries Kit (soap, tooth brush, tooth paste, floss, comb, mirror)
	Personal medications
1	Hand towel
1	Bath towel (showers will be available in some form always!)
1	Watch (the Scouts stay on a schedule while camping)
1	Pen/pencil/notebook (small and able to fit in pack)
1	Water bottle on some type of belt (for hiking)
1	Mess Kit (cup, bowl, plate and utensils)
1	Flashlight
1	Small tube of sunscreen
1	Small tube/can of insect/mosquito repellent
1	Swim suit and appropriate closed-toed water shoes
1	Fishing Pole (optional)

Troop 243 Uniform Policy

“Class A Uniform” – consists of the khaki BSA dress shirt, Scout shorts/long pants, Scout belt and Scout socks. It is worn anytime we travel away from our Troop Meeting location and also for Courts of Honor, Boards of Review, Crossover Ceremonies, religious ceremonies, etc. and other special occasions.

“Class B Uniform” – consists of the Troop 243 T-shirt instead of the khaki BSA dress shirt, Scout shorts/long pants, Scout belt and Scout socks. It is worn to all Troop and Patrol Meetings and is worn during most campout activities.
